The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run 2019 - Terms and Conditions

- These terms and conditions apply to The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run on Sunday 6 October 2019 at Holyrood Park, London and all associated transactions.
- To take part, participants agree to pay a registration fee of £12.50 and to raise a minimum of £100 in sponsorship per adult.
- Participants may use the 'in aid of' logo of Target Ovarian Cancer (which can be obtained from the fundraising team) for fundraising purposes connected with The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run, provided always that they shall not bring the name of Target Ovarian Cancer into disrepute in any way.
- All sponsorship money raised must be donated to Target Ovarian Cancer and cannot be used for a participant's expenses.
- All fundraising undertaken by a participant must adhere to the Institute of Fundraising guidelines. Please visit www.institute-of-fundraising.org.uk for more information.
- All registration payments are non-refundable.
- Sponsorship money raised must be submitted to Target Ovarian Cancer by 20 December 2019.
- All money raised must be for Target Ovarian Cancer and cannot be split with any other organisation.
- If a participant is unable to take part and sponsors wish to retain a refund for their sponsorship Target Ovarian Cancer must receive a written request for this from the sponsors.
- Registration closes on Friday 4 October at 12pm or as soon as all spaces are full according to health and safety regulations.
- Any participant under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is responsible for them on the day.
- Participants are responsible for their own medical conditions. You should be reasonably fit to take part in this event and you are strongly advised to undertake some training. If you have any doubts about your ability to take part including without limitation having pre-existing medical conditions you should contact your doctor to seek advice.
- Target Ovarian Cancer is working to ensure the event is managed to high standards and will take reasonable measures to minimise the risk of injury to participants. Walking and running are active sports and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of the organisation of the event you are taking part in. By signing these terms and conditions you voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in this event and agree that Target Ovarian Cancer shall not be liable for any loss, injury or damage, howsoever caused (except that Target Ovarian Cancer does not exclude liability for death or personal injury caused by either their negligence or that of their employees).
- In an emergency Target Ovarian Cancer has participants' permission to hand participants' personal details over to the emergency services.
- All spectators at The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run are there at their own risk. Target Ovarian Cancer is not responsible for any loss, injury or damage that might occur during the day (except that Target Ovarian Cancer does not exclude liability for death or personal injury caused by its negligence or that of its employees).
- Target Ovarian Cancer reserves the right to change the route of The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run at any point.
- Target Ovarian Cancer reserves the right to refuse entry to a participant if their taking part is considered unsafe at any point.
- Target Ovarian Cancer operates a no smoking policy at all events.
- Target Ovarian Cancer requests that participants do not use aggressive or abusive language towards organisers or volunteers at The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run.
- Availability of tshirt sizes is limited. If the requested size is no longer available Target Ovarian Cancer will provide an alternative size based on availability.
- Emergency contact data is required to assist with a medical or other emergency. It will not be used for marketing purposes and will be removed from our database within 2 months of the event.
- Medical details are captured to assist with a medical incident and will be shared with medical personnel. The data will be from our database within 2 months of the event, unless required as part of an investigation into specific accident/incident in which case it will be destroyed as soon as possible after the investigation has concluded.
- By taking part in The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run participants confirm that Target Ovarian Cancer can use their names and any movie/video footage or images to publicise The Ovarian Cancer Walk | Run or Target Ovarian Cancer in the future.
- If any part of these terms and conditions is found to be invalid or unlawful for any reason, that part may be disregarded and all the other terms and conditions shall continue to be effective.

These terms and conditions shall be governed and construed by English Law in all respects and the parties to these terms and conditions irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales in relation to the event in London, and by Scottish Law and to the Courts of Scotland in relation to the event in Scotland.
